

Guide for Biostar 2 Login Page Access Issue and BioMini Not Found Issue Due to Browser Updates

There is an issue where the login page of BioStar 2 does not appear correctly, and the BioMini is not found in **Google Chrome version 117 or higher** and **Microsoft Edge version 117 or higher**.


This guide outlines the procedure to resolve the issue.



- This patch is only applicable for BioStar v2.5.0 or higher.
- This guide is only applicable when using certificates issued by BioStar 2.
- If a private certificate is used but still experiencing this issue, the private certificate needs to be regenerated including **Digital Signature** and **Key Encipherment** in the **Key Usage**. [\[Support Link\]](#)

How to Patch

- 1 Right-click on the **resetCert.bat** file inside the patch folder, and select **Run as administrator**.

If you are unable to **Run as an administrator**, please refer to the **How to Patch Manually** guide and proceed with the patch manually.


2 The patch is in progress. Please do not close the window until the patch is complete.




- If you are using USB Agent or Unified Gateway, the patch may not be applied correctly unless you reboot the PC.
- If you see a message stating that the certificate is untrusted when accessing [\[Link\]](#) after rebooting the PC using the USB Agent, please designate it as a trusted certificate in your browser.

Troubleshooting

Unable to Access BioStar 2 Login Page After Patch

- Check whether you have run the **resetCert.bat** file as an administrator.





If you are unable to Run as an administrator or if you have already run the patch with Run as an administrator and still cannot access the login page, please refer to the **How to Patch Manually** guide and proceed with the patch manually.

How to Patch Manually


Go to  Start → Services, and then please stop all BioStar 2 services, including the USB Agent if it's used.

How to Check BioStar 2 Version


- The 'How to Patch Manually' differs depending on the version of BioStar 2 installed. Please refer to the 'How to Patch Manually' that matches the installed version.
- You can check the version of the BioStar 2 you are using by opening the **info.json** file with Notepad located at the following path.
 - [C:\Program Files\BioStar 2\(x64\)\nginx\html\js](C:\Program Files\BioStar 2(x64)\nginx\html\js)



BioStar v2.8.15 or higher

1 Copy the files below from the patch folder.


- **biostar-cert.exe**
- **resetCert.bat**

2 Paste the copied files within the BioStar 2 installation folder.

- BioStar 2 default installation folder: [C:\Program Files\BioStar 2\(x64\)](C:\Program Files\BioStar 2(x64))



- If using the USB Agent, copy the certificate file in the **usb-agent\config** folder and then paste it into the USB Agent installation path.
 - USB Agent default installation folder: [C:\Program Files \(x86\)\USB Device Agent\usb-agent\config](C:\Program Files (x86)\USB Device Agent\usb-agent\config)
- If you see a message stating that the certificate is untrusted when accessing [\[Link\]](#) after copying the certificate file to the USB Agent installation folder, please designate it as a trusted certificate in your browser.

3 Right-click on the pasted **resetCert.bat** file and **Run as an administrator**.





4 Go to  **Start** → **Services**, and then please restart all BioStar 2 services that you stopped.

BioStar v2.8.14 or lower

1 Copy the folder and files below from the patch folder.


- jre folder
- biostar-cert.exe
- resetCert.bat

2 Paste the copied files within the BioStar 2 installation folder.

- BioStar 2 default installation folder: [C:\Program Files\BioStar 2\(x64\)](C:\Program Files\BioStar 2(x64))



3 Right-click on the pasted **resetCert.bat** file and **Run as an administrator**.



4 Go to  **Start** → **Services**, and then please restart all BioStar 2 services that you stopped.

When Failing to Find the Path to a Key File When Running the resetCert.bat File

- 1 Run the **Command Prompt (cmd)** as an administrator using **Run** (Win + R).
- 2 Go to the BioStar 2 installation folder in **Command Prompt (cmd)** and run the **resetCert.bat** file.
